Award recipients will then be judged, and Maryland ACTE award winners will have their nominations forwarded on to be considered for the ACTE Region I Awards.

The nomination deadline is December 30, 2021. Nominees **do not** have to be a member of ACTE to be eligible for the state award. A nominee must be a member of ACTE if they want to go on to compete for the Region 1 and national awards.
